Case Study

- Enforcement order official July 2014
- Pond system
- Violations
 - Failed to submit five months of DMRs and annual report
 - Failed to maintain BOD, TSS, and pH levels



Case Study

- Resolved reporting requirements
- Had issues lowering BOD levels
- City Manager was cooperative
- Assigned an EnviroMentor




Case Study

- EnviroMentor assessed the situation
- Led the city to:
 - Repair lift station
 - Better maintain vegetation
 - Repair aeration sprinklers
- In 2019, system was out of enforcement
